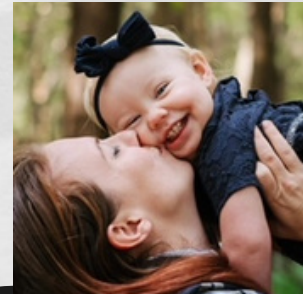
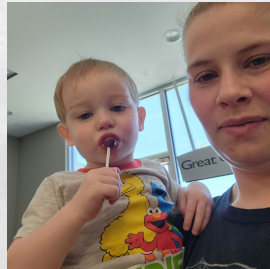
A GLIMPSE INTO 2024
